What is our ambition for enrichment?

Our enrichment offer aims to help every child flourish by providing opportunities that develop confidence, aspiration, spirituality, cultural understanding, creativity and resilience through 6 key focus areas:

- **Civic engagement** – volunteering, pupil leadership and pupil voice, school democracy, debating, community engagement and charity fundraising.
- **Arts and culture** – taking part in and having live experiences of music art, dance, theatre, other expressive arts, visit to museums and galleries.
- **Nature, outdoors and adventure** – time outdoors climate education, sustainability projects, gardening, residential and camps
- **Sports and physical activities** – participating in individual and team sports, physical activities like dance, fitness activities or cycling, representing school or college, attending live events.
- **Developing wider life and future skills** – digital literacy, STEM clubs, enterprise, cooking and managing finances
- **Spiritual / Christian life** - leading collective worship, church services, faith groups
